What is Connect?

Adolescence is a remarkable developmental period, in which children are transformed neurobiologically, cognitively and interpersonally as they prepare for adult roles and relationships. The confluence of these diverse changes make adolescence a sensitive developmental period, where vulnerability increases but opportunities for growth are also heightened.

Connect is an evidence-based 10week program developed to support parents and caregivers of preteens and teens who are struggling to understand and respond to challenging behaviour.

Connect supports parents to make choices that support healthy relationships with their children while also setting limits and teaching new skills.

What is Family Solutions?

The Family Solutions program has been designed to support parents, caregivers, children, and youth to enhance relationships and mitigate conflict.

Our counselors utilize recognized approaches to facilitate personal growth and overcome mental health challenges.

We are a trauma-informed practice that utilizes an attachment-based parenting approach when supporting the families that we work with.
